



ABSTRACTS FOR THE CLINICAL PAPER SESSIONS AT THE BAIN FALLON

Abstracts should be A4, one side in the following format:

1. Title
2. Authors and affiliations
3. Introduction
4. Materials and Methods or Case History (including any diagnostic tests/techniques)
5. Results or Clinical Outcome
6. Relevance to Clinical Equine Practice

A paragraph on each of the items 3 to 6 should suffice. We need the abstracts to be informative, so such statements as "...results will be presented..." are unacceptable. All the information you will present must be in the abstract. Any advertisements for commercial products must not be included in these presentations. You can mention registered drug names and dose rates if they are critical to the information presented. You are reminded that abstracts should not contain citations to published literature.

The presentation time is 10 minutes with an additional 5 minutes for questions and discussion. The purpose of the clinical papers is to inform attendees of clinical research or case experience that they can use in their own practices for the benefit of clients and their horses. Abstracts need to be submitted by 18 March 2011. The abstracts will be available to delegates at the conference in time for the presentations.

You will be notified by email if your abstract has been accepted. EVA members will be eligible for the EVA Norman Larkin Prize or the EVA Reginald R Pascoe Prize.
